Before you and your furry friend join us for WaterBARK Day, we kindly ask that you take a moment to read through our event rules. These guidelines are in place to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone.

RULES

Vaccinations and Health Requirements:

- All dogs must be current on vaccinations, including rabies, distemper, and parvovirus.
- Dogs must be spayed/neutered.
- Dogs must be free of contagious illnesses or parasites.
- Owners must provide proof of vaccinations upon entry.

Behavior and Supervision:

- All dogs must be well-behaved and non-aggressive.
- Dogs showing signs of aggression or disruptive behavior will be asked to leave the event.
- Owners must supervise their dogs at all times and maintain control.

Leash Policy:

- Dogs must be on a leash when entering and exiting the park.
- Dogs may be off leash only in designated areas and under strict supervision.

Clean-Up:

- Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.
- Waste bags will be provided at various locations throughout the park.

Safety:

- Dogs must wear appropriate identification tags and collar (no pinch or choke collars allowed).
- No dogs in heat are allowed.
- Owners are responsible for their dog's safety and well-being.

Water Safety:

- Owners must monitor their dogs while swimming.
- Dogs must not drink pool water. Fresh drinking water will be provided.
- This event is for dogs and is not open swim to humans.
- ****Humans will enter the water per dog at their own risk.****

Age and Size Restrictions:

- Dogs must be at least six months old to participate.
- Separate areas will be designated for small and large dogs for safety.

Food, Treats and Toys:

- Owners should not bring outside food or treats for dogs into the park.
- Please do not bring toys. We will provide floatable toys only. Dog life jackets are allowed.

Personal Belongings:

- The park is not responsible for lost or damaged personal belongings.

Weather Policy:

- The event will proceed in light rain. In the event of severe weather, the event may be rescheduled or canceled.
